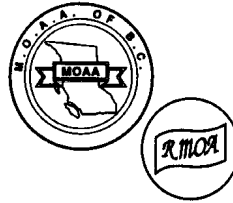

Better Health – Better Recovery Dr. T. Clarke

Dr. Teresa Clarke is a graduate of the University of British Columbia where she obtained an Honours Bachelor of Science degree in Biochemistry and a Doctorate of Medicine (UBC, M.D. 1981). She practiced as a family physician for 10 years prior to developing an interest in integrative medicine. She has a special interest in mind-body medicine and is trained in acupuncture and clinical hypnosis. She believes that the science of medicine is only one aspect of wellness and that we can reach our highest potential for healing when science is integrated with active engagement in self-care and we explore the many ways in which body, mind and spirit can be supported to a state of optimal health. As the Director of Outreach Services at Inspire-Health she oversees the delivery of InspireHealth's Outreach programs to the community.

The Lowdown Mood Disorders Assoc. of BC

A panel of young people speaks on living with bipolar disorder. They share their different experiences leading up to their diagnoses and openly discuss their journey and the struggles they face day to day. The Mood Disorders Association of BC is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing support, education and hope of recovery for those living with a mood disorder or other mental illness. Building awareness throughout the province and reaching out to as many people as possible, assists in the support and education for people with mood disorders, their families and friends, and builds an understanding community.
