

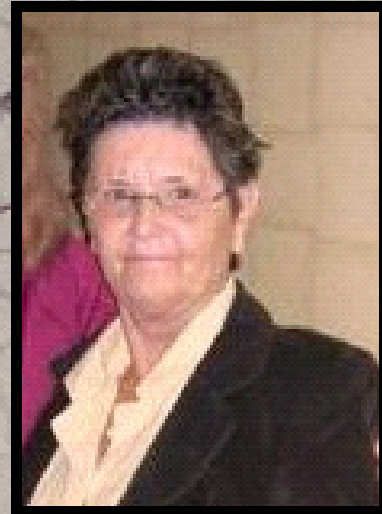


RATCLIFFE, Sheila Ann (Terri)
